Accessibility



Public Areas

Public hotel areas are accessible by wheelchairs.

Entrance

The hotel main entrance and all five buildings entrances are provided with ramps. Ramps and stairs in the hotel entrance and in five of the five buildings provide handrails.

Lifts

Lifts are available in four of the five buildings and they are quite spacious for wheelchairs. Their door opening is 90cm. The highest lift button is 1.40cm. Braille raised letters are available.

Parking

There is a large parking available at the hotel. All Building entrances are accessible by vehicles.

Stairs

Handrails are available in most all the internal and external stairs where required.

Rooms & Bathrooms

All rooms entrance doors and bathroom doors are accessible by wheelchairs.

Access to the restaurants and lounge bare is available by ramps with handrails.

Swimming Pools

Both swimming pools are accessible by wheelchairs

Gardens & Hotel Beach

Beach in front is accessible by wheelchair.

Hotel sorroundings are mostly flat providing the possibility of wheelchair use through tiled pathways

Tsilivi Resort & Zakynthos Island

Tsilivi is situated on the North East coast of the idyllic island of Zakynthos or Zante (as it is widely known), 9km from the airport and 5km from the capital of the island, Zante Town.

It has fast become one of the main tourist resorts on the island, bustling with many traditional family run tavernas, restaurants, bars and night clubs making it one of the island's 'hot spots' for entertaining nightlife.

Originally a small resort, it has expanded in recent years and become THE place to stay for lively exciting holidays without moving away from its traditional Greek heritage.



The resort is set amongst olive groves and vineyards and its special features include a fantastic golden

sandy beach of around 2km long that is well worthy of its Blue Flag, an award for clean beaches.



The sand shelves gently into the sea making it the ideal place for children to enjoy themselves in complete safety. The long promenade offers the chance for romantics walks through the local shops ending on the long sandy beach.

The friendly and fun atmosphere combined with the natural beauty of Greece and the guaranteed sunny weather makes this resort an ideal setting for people of all ages – a perfect holiday!



Zakynthos (Zante the flower of the East)

Zákynthos (Zante) is a **verdant island** endowed with fertile valleys and a temperate climate (area: 406 sq. km; coastline: 123 km). Its landscape diversity has resulted in different types of beaches. There are sandy beaches in secluded coves where the tranquil waters are deep blue on the island's southeastern part; yet, if rugged cliffs and an interesting **underwater world** are to your liking, try the western part of the island.

The Venetians, who ruled Zákynthos from 1484 to 1797, called the island "**Fioro di Levante**" (flower of the East) as there are over 7,000 species of flowers on Zákynthos. Zákynthos is said to have been the island's first inhabitant and the ancient acropolis is attributed to him. He was the son of Dardanos who ruled the ancient kingdom of Frigia. A Venetian fort was built at later times on the site.

The Venetian architectural influence has left its stamp on Zante despite the damage sustained due to the seismic activity in the area. After the ravaging 1953 earthquake and the ensuing fire, a number of historical buildings and churches burned to the ground. Consequently, the significant treasures these buildings were housing perished. The town **was rebuilt** according to a plan where strict anti-seismic specifications applied and, to a large extent, respecting the town's former architectural structure.

On Zante, great care is taken to protect two endangered animal species, namely the **Caretta Caretta** sea turtle and the **Monachus Monachus** seal.

Zakynthos Town Visit

- The **Solomos Square** surrounded by buildings with characteristic traditional architectural features of the island, arch-shaped windows and arcades.
- The **Post- Byzantine Museum of Zante** in Solomos square, exhibits treasures such as statues trimmed with gold, icons and art woodcuts.
- Aghios Dionysios Church.
- The **Aghios Markos square**. Here, in 1797, the revolutionaries (popolaroi) burnt the Libro d' Oro and planted the tree of freedom. The **Venetian Castle** situated on a hill overhanging the town in the place of the old acropolis named Psofis.
- The **Stranis hill,** 2 km away from the town, offering a great view. Here, the poet Dionysios Solomos inspired the 'Hymn to Liberty' (later the Greek national anthem) and the "Free Besieged" attending the siege of the city of Messolonghi.



Top Zakynthos Attractions



Zakynthos Town

The town is best enjoyed on foot. Explore its paved streets and squares and take your time to really explore the local arts and produce generously available from corner to corner. From bakeries to cafes, local markets, sweet shops, clothes and jewellery boutiques to picturesque neighbourhoods, museums and hidden heritage (like the English cemetery), Zakynthos Town has it all.



Anafonitria monastery

Approximately 25 k from Zakynthos is the small village of Anafonitria situated near Volimes and hosting a beautiful 15th century Byzantine monastery, which was built in honour of the Virgin Mary. It was in this monastery that the patron saint of Zakynhtos, Agios Dionysios, lived the last years of his life as a monk.



Port Limnionas

Some 25k from the town and just off Agios Leon in the West there is Limnionas a beautiful unspoiled lagoon with transparent and emerald green waters. There is no beach as such but plenty of flat rocks you can sunbathe on. The best experience is diving into the freezing cold waters of the bay a combination of sea currents and underwater streams



Marathonisi (Turtle Island)

The small islet is situated in Laganas bay and provides one of the nesting homes for the loggerhead turtle Caretta Caretta. Its turtled-shape formation has evoked a number of myths over the years one of which is that it was carved by the ancients in honour of the visiting creature! Restrictions for visiting the islet are imposed by the National Marine Park in order to protect the nesting grounds in the area.



Top Zakynthos Attractions



StradaMarina

Starting at Zakynthos Port on the Argasi side by the church and bell tower of Agios Dionysios take a slow walk on the sea front, also known as Strada Marina, and enjoy the beautiful scenes of fishermen and sailing boats, local shops, cafeterias and horse-drawn carriage tours.



Bochali

Just 2 km from Zakynthos Town, at the top of the hill is Bochali (or Mpohali). Overlooking the port, neighbourhoods and streets below (as well as Argasi to the right) one can take in the wonderful views of the town and port below, the sea and beyond. Visit Mpohali in the morning to enjoy a relaxed breakfast and coffee or by night to indulge in a moonlit dinner or cocktails at the many beautiful lounge bars and cafeterias.



Suinset at Shiza

Visit the small picturesque village of Kampi to the west of the island and follow the steep drive up to the top of the hill where a big cross memorial stands in honour of those murdered during the civil war in Greece (literally thrown off the cliff and sent to their deaths). On the way up you will find the Mycenaean cemetery with original tombs of that era.



Navagio (Shipwreck) & Blue Caves

Two of the most well-known destinations, not only in Zakynthos but the whole of Greece, can only be accessed by the sea. The famous Shipwreck, which is the most photographed beach in the country, is positioned on the west coast of the island under the famous and picturesque mountainous village of Volimes. In 1983 an illegal boat carrying cigarettes was washed off the shore of the Agios Georgios bay as it was then known.
